Policing in New Brunswick

- Provincial Policing Service Agreement (PPSA)
- Municipal Police Service Agreement (MPSA)
- Municipal/ Regional Police Forces

Agreements

- Provincial Police Service Agreement (PPSA):
 - Is an Agreement between the Province and Canada
 - Cost sharing is based on a provincial-federal ratio of 70-30.
- Provincial/Municipal Policing Agreements:
 - Is an Agreement between the Province (JPS) and the communities
 - With RCMP as a service provider

Contract Management Committee

- Is a national committee with representatives from each of the Provinces and Territories receiving RCMP provincial policing, one from Public Safety Canada and one from the RCMP
- Holds in-person meetings bi-annually
- Is an information sharing forum on issues affecting the governance, cost and quality of police services prior to decisions being made

Budget Process

- J Division Multi-year Financial Plan
- Justice and Public Safety Budget Submission
- Cost Recovery Process
- Budget Letter
