WHEREAS the owner of a property, located within the boundaries of a municipality,

may prepare and submit an application for a Watercourse and Wetland

Alteration Permit to the Department of Environment and Local

Government; and

WHEREAS the application shall then be reviewed and evaluated by the Department

of Environment and Local Government; and

WHEREAS after consideration by the Department of Environment and Local

Government, a Watercourse and Wetland Alteration Permit may be

issued to the property owner; and

WHEREAS the above review, evaluation and consideration of the said application

and the subsequent issuance of the permit may be carried out without consultation with a representative of the municipality in which the

property is located. Therefore, be it

RESOLVED THAT the Union of Municipalities of New Brunswick request that the

Department of Environment and Local Government ensure that the operating process(es) and / or procedure(s) for processing applications for Watercourse and Wetland Alteration Permits include consultation with municipal officials, prior to issuing a permit or denying same, when

the property in question is located within the boundaries of a

municipality.
