RESOLUTION U – 16 - 02

VILLAGE OF GAGETOWN

WHEREAS provincial services have been removed from many New Brunswick Municipalities without consultation between the Province and impacted municipalities including court houses, Service New Brunswick Centers and the Jemseg – Gagetown ferry and,

WHEREAS the local impact of a service being withdrawn from a municipality cannot be completely understood without communicating through consultation between the Province and impacted municipality prior to the announcement and actual removal of a provincial service from a municipality and,

WHEREAS it is in the best interests of the Provincial Government to have municipalities contribute, through consultation, to the process of evaluating any provincial service within said municipality and,

WHEREAS there must be an appropriate consultation process legislated that clearly outlines the involvement of a municipality along with the Provincial Government, in coming to any decision that involves the potential reduction and/or removal of a provincial service from the municipalities directly implicated and,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Government of New Brunswick work with UMNB to draft a process, to be legislated, that clearly ensures municipalities will be consulted with by the Government of New Brunswick when a provincial service within said municipality is being considered/evaluated for reduction and/or removal.
