Subject: Route 108

WHEREAS Highways of the Province of New Brunswick are the arteries through which commerce brings economic security and development to the many rural municipalities of New Brunswick and its rural areas.

WHEREAS It has been stated many times by Premier Gallant and his Government of the need for major Highway Infrastructure repairs and upgrades.
