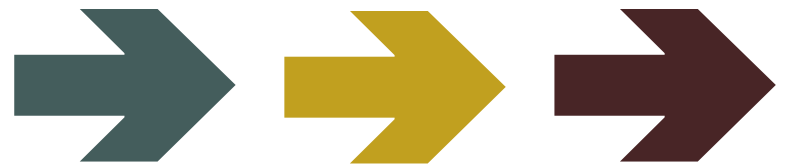

About UMNB

The Union of Municipalities of New Brunswick (UMNB) represents 60 municipalities across the province of all sizes and both official languages, advocating for strong, sustainable local governments. We bring municipal voices together to influence policy, share knowledge, and strengthen local leadership.

To build stronger connections between municipalities and key partners, UMNB is proud to introduce the Associate Membership Program, an opportunity for organizations that share our goals to collaborate, contribute, and connect with New Brunswick’s municipal network.

Program Purpose

The UMNB Associate Membership Program is designed to:

- Support municipal advocacy, research, and training through diversified revenue.
- Provide a formal channel for non-municipal stakeholders to engage in UMNB initiatives.

Membership Categories

Member Type	Description	Examples	Annual Fee
Partner	Government and public-sector organizations supporting municipal work.	Regional Service Commissions, Provincial Departments, Crown Corporations, etc...	\$1,500
Associate Member (Rural Districts)	Rural Districts seeking to engage with municipalities and participate in UMNB initiatives and training.	Rural Districts	\$2,000
For-Profit Organizations	Businesses, corporations, and professional associations involved in municipal-related industries.	Construction or Engineering Firms, Chambers of Commerce, Consultants, Private Industry etc...	\$1,000
Non-Profit Supporters	Non-profit or community organizations whose goals align with UMNB’s mission and priorities.	Provincial Non-Profits, Charitable Organizations, Association,	\$250

All associate membership categories are **non-voting** and subject to approval by UMNB’s Governance Committee.

All applications are reviewed and approved by the **UMNB Governance Committee** or its designate to ensure alignment with UMNB's values and strategic priorities.

Application & Renewal

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. Once approved, invoices for membership dues will be issued annually. Memberships are valid for one calendar year and are renewable upon payment.

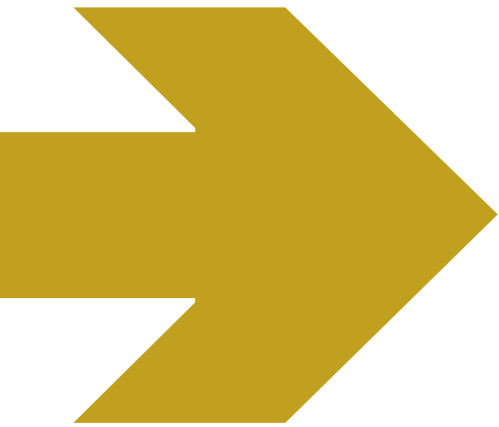
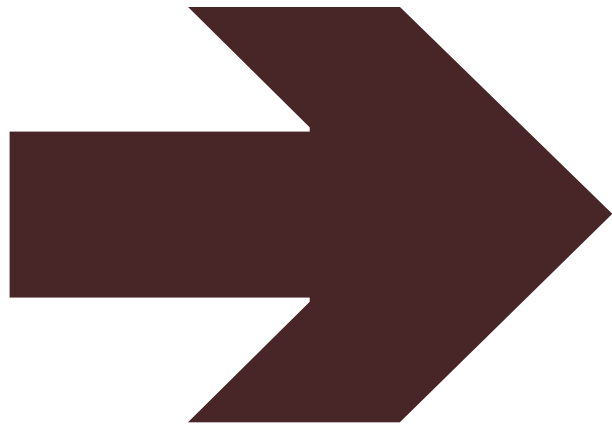
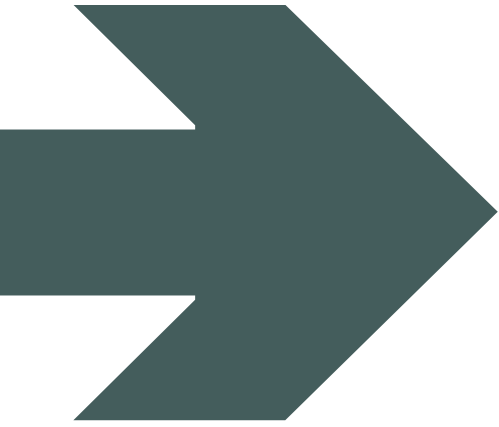
